SPEAKING OF NEIGH-BORHOOD WATCH....

I attended a coordinators' meeting last week (entering a plea for their help with the Neighborhood Directory, which they were very gracious in granting). A representative from DeKalb Police was there talking about criminal activity in our community. In the Dunwoody North area alone from February to June 1993 there were twenty-nine incidents reported. One weekend in August there were four incidents, including breaking and entering, car theft, and burglary. The offenders are getting more bold, smashing in doors, entering when residents are at home. and breaking in during broad daylight.

WHAT CAN WE DO?

Report crimes immediately: first to the police, dial 911; then notify your Block Captain who will alert the coordinator and other neighbors.

➤ Join Neighborhood Watch and become familiar with recommended procedures. Your Block Captain has information available. If you don't know who your block captain is, call Linda Fugitt at 451-7025, or Stan Sloan at 451-8316.

> Know that after school hours and weekends are prime times for criminal activity. Be extra alert and cautious

Do not leave valuables (purses, jewelry, money, credit eards, keys, drugs) in view from your windows -- especially the kitchen door and windows. These are prime targets for a quick break in, grab, and run.

WELCOME NEW NEIGHBORS!


